

Grass Pod

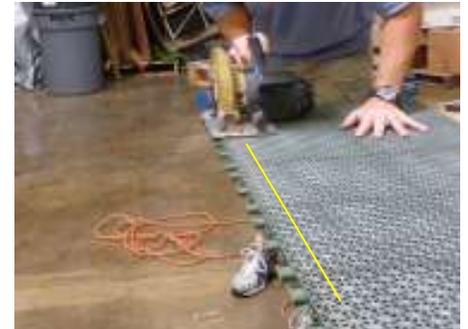
Construction Manual

Step 1 – Measure Your Exact Dimensions

- Measure the area you would like to cover with one or more pods
- Be sure to have your length and width measurements in addition to the totals

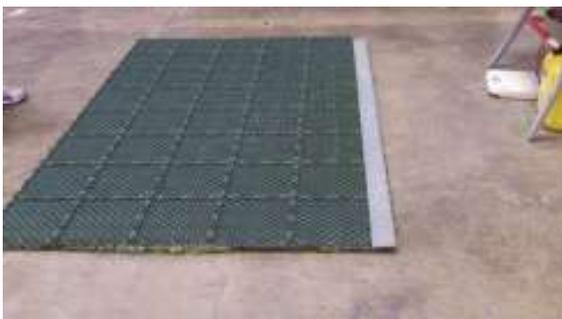
Step 2 – Make Your Tiles Fit Your Dimensions

- Snap tiles together, mark tiles that need to be cut, cut to size
- Helps to use a chalk line when cutting a long straight edge



Step 3 – Snap Tiles Together and Place on Back of Turf

- May need to mark and cut turf to fit pod
- When possible, cut the turf in between rows of stitching, otherwise use a chalk line
- May need to add holes to turf at 6" intervals at second row in of holes in tiles, can use a soldering iron, drill, Dremel tool or even a nail to make your holes – just be careful!



Step 4 – Flip Over and Attach Turf to Tiles with Included Zip Ties

- Lift edge with foot, push zip ties through bottom and through closest hole
- DO NOT pull zip ties tight at this point, get them started and about 80% pulled



Step 5 – Finish Zip Ties, Put into Place, Enjoy

- To finish zip tie, pull fibers out from under zip tie, get snug and pull tight
- Cut extra zip tie and move buckle to under the tile
